



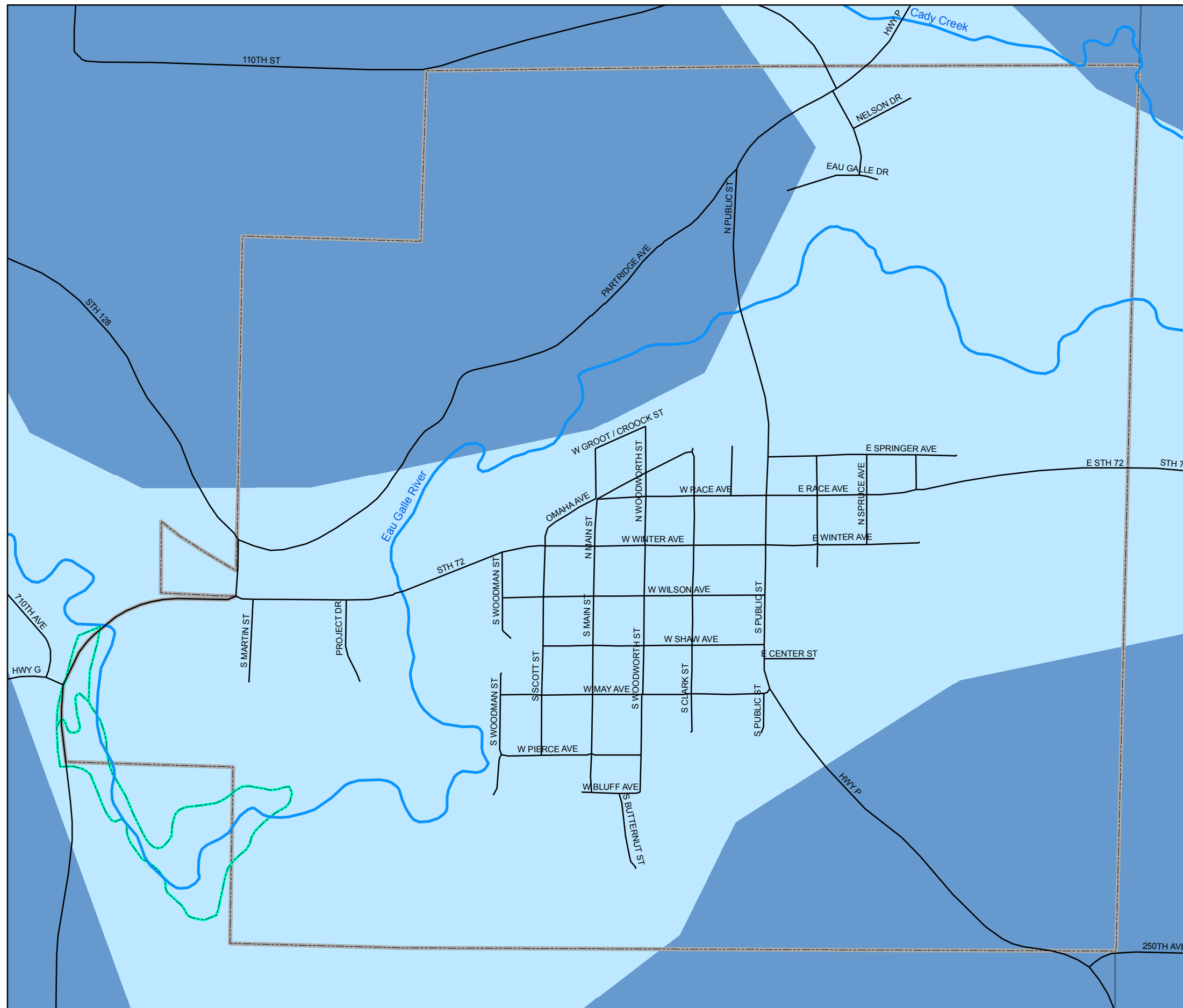


Village of Elmwood

Groundwater is an important resource for Wisconsin as about 75% of its residents rely on it for their source of drinking water. About 15-30% of all precipitation in Wisconsin ends up as groundwater. The depth to water table is the distance from the land surface to the water table. The distance water must flow to reach the groundwater, combined with the ease in which movement occurs, plays a significant role in determining the susceptibility of an area to contamination.
